Parnitha parents were Hindus, his father comes from a well to do family, once he accepted Christ as his personal savior, his parents persecuted him, his brothers beat him and locked him in a dark room for three days, where he suffered like a cruel criminal without proper food and water and promised him freedom and future security, if only he forsakes his new found faith. He refused to oblige to their demand, but instead chose to suffer. His family members became tired of persuading him to give-up but ended up losing their battle.

They finally threw him and his wife out of the house, Parnitha's father then found a job in a small hotel where he worked as a dish washer, he was faithful in washing the dishes and the hotel owner who observed his faithfulness promoted him to be a cook.

Where he is ekeing a miserabel living by cooking and his being paid just \$ 1.50 cents and he has to work for fifteen hours a day. And he has to spend 30 cents on his travel. Therefore he is unable to provide proper secutiry to his family. Nor rent any shack in the slum therefore they live in a shack owned by a money lender. His wife too works as a domestic maid where she earns around 60 cents a day. For quite sometimes she wanted to go back to her inlaws house because of poverty but was convicted of her sins and recieved Christ as her savior and decided to be in poverty and enjoy spiritual blessings. They both attend our church and decided to take Christian name for their daughter as Nithya ie eternal.

They are rejoicing in the Lord and their only concern was their daughter, they feared that she would be malnourished and suffer complication due to poverty. By then we announced about Touch A Life program, they feel this is God sent for their daughter .
